HONG KONG-Disney officially opened its newest theme park in Hong Kong, its first step into the lucrative (有利的) China market.

The ceremony opening of the US \$ 3.5-billion park kicked off with a traditional Chinese lion dance in the forecourt of Sleeping Beauty Castle.

The Hong Kong government, which chipped in 1.8 billion Hong Kong dollars of the construction cost and owned a half-share of equity in the project, is hoping the park will spur (鼓励) local tourism and bring in more than 100 billion dollars over the next 40 years.

The attraction and its two resort hotels are surrounded by mountains on lush Lantau Island, just 30 minutes away by subway from bustling central Hong Kong. It looks much like the first Disneyland in California, with a Space Mountain thrill ride, a classic Cinderella Carousel and a pink Sleeping Beauty Castle — which Disney predicts will be one of the most photographed buildings in Asia.

Hong Kong's government says the attraction will help turn this global financial capital into Asia's best family holiday spot.

Disney hopes the park — the 11st in its global empire — will be a magnet for increasingly wealthy Chinese tourists, who have a reputation for being big-spenders.

Michael Eisner, Disney's chief executive officer (CEO), said China and Disneyland will be a perfect match because they both value families. "You go to the park and you see mothers, daughters and kids and grandparents. The family unit in China is unbelievably strong. It's not just Hong Kong, it's the Chinese mainland," Eisner said.

A woman whose sports car was stolen with her dog in it put up notices all over the area that made it clear getting back her pet was more important than her car.

"Whoever did this can keep my car. Please let Benjerman come home ," the notice said.

It was not known if the thief showed any pity ,but almost 30 hours after the 1 p. m. theft Friday ,Kimberly Atkins of Dover and Benjerman , a 12-year-old black retriever(猎犬) ,were reunited after police located them in Barrington.

"He 's hungry ,he 's dirty ,but he 's very happy to be home ," Atkins said.

The car was found at about 5 p. m. Saturday off Route 125 in a swampy area frequented by off-the-road cars and dirt bikes. However ,police couldn 't control Benjerman ,and they had to call Atkins to come to get him.

Atkins said the thief cared for Benjerman a little by providing him with some dry cat food. She believed Benjerman ended up drinking some muddy water in the area.

She said they have been together for nearly 11 years after she took him back from a society shelter(收容所) in Dallas ,Texas.

Before Benjerman was found ,Atkins and several friends put up notices all over the city and in Somersworth. They also contacted(联系) animal shelters throughout southern New Hampshire and Massachusetts.

The notice stated there was a reward ,and also that the dog needed medication. Any caller could remain anonymous(匿名的).

Atkins had parked the car outside a hardware store with the keys inside and gone in to rent a carpet cleaner.

"It was 10 minutes and I came out and my car was gone along with Benjerman in broad daylight ," Atkins said.

The car thief threw Atkins ' wallet and other personal items out of the car before escaping from the scene.

More than 200 years ago , Italian scientist Luigi Spallanzani showed that younger animals have a greater ability to regenerate lost parts than older animals. So do animals lower on the ladder of evolutionary(进化的) development. At a time when society is changing by the minute and everything seems unsure , the sense of insecurity is also growing. That is probably one of the reasons the insurance industry has grown so fast in recent years. According to China 's economic statistic(统计) , insurance revenues have been increasing by more than 30 per cent every year since China 's reforms and opening-up started. There are already 18 insurance companies competing in Beijing and another 17 expected to enter the market this year.

When insurance companies hire new hands , sincerity , an enterprising nature , willingness to accept challenges , and good communication skills are emphasized. Life insurance companies also tend to prefer people with a medical or legal background , while property insurance companies like people with specialized knowledge for assessing compensation (赔偿判定) amounts. Still , many companies look at the overall qualities of an applicant. Outstanding people with some working experience are what are most needed now , especially in sales , said Xue Wen , head of human resources at Zhonghang Sanxing Life Insurance Company. It is also important that they have lots of experience in dealing with people and in networking.

For some technical positions like financial work and compensation assessment , a sound higher education background may be enough. " We accept finance majors every year because the work doesn 't involve much contact with people , " Huang Huajing , human resources manager at the Sino-US Met Life Insurance Co , was quoted by Beijing 's Life Style newspaper as saying.

And new graduates can make good sales people , too. Many companies have training programs to help the green hands. Some even set a probationary(试用) period during which the new employees get a base salary without selling anything. People 's Insurance of China has a one-year program for new people. Wang Jingzhe , a civil engineering major who graduated last year joined People 's Insurance as a compensation evaluator and said that he really enjoyed his work there. " Every single case is unique and you can 't find solutions that fit textbook examples perfectly. An insurance company is a good place for you to learn a lot. "
