英 语(第七模拟)

【命题报告】 本套试卷难度适中,区分度较好。所选试题材料新颖,设计科学,对知识、能力的考查到位,而且重点突出。具体地表现为以下几个方面:

1. 单项选择题重点突出了对动词、句型结构、从句的考查。在语境中考查语言的具体运用,突出了语言的工具性,较好地体现了高考的命题导向和要求。
2. 完形填空题材富有极强的教育意义,对考生很有启示。所有试题都是在语境中考查对文章意思的理解和词汇的辨析。难点在于对文章意思的正确理解,解题关键在于做到文章内容的前后紧密联系。
3. 阅读理解题材新颖,体裁多样化,重点考查考生对文章的理解能力和推理判断能力。
4. 短文改错题材贴近学生生活,考点分布合理,考查重点突出。
5. 书面表达题材和内容均接近学生生活,使学生有内容可写,较好地体现了高考命题的思路。

There 's a great story about an old Finnish woman who , without quite realizing it , was using her cellphone to access the Internet and track her city 's public transit system. When asked why she used the wireless Internet so usually , she replied , " What are you talking about ? All I know is I click on something on my cellphone and it says ' buses ' . I click it again and it tells me the bus I 'm waiting for is three minutes away. I keep hitting this refresh button and it says the bus is two minutes away , one minute away , and then it just shows up. I don 't know anything about this wireless Internet stuff , I just know the bus is here. "

Regardless of whether you want to admit it , a lot of us are like that old Finnish woman. When it comes to new mobile applications , many of us do not realize the capability and power that we hold in our hands.

What we 're looking at today is the mobile Internet in its infancy(初期). Now that using the Internet from home or work has saturated much of society , the next logical step is to be able to use the Net when you 're away from your laptop. Speech recognition is one way to do this , and there are a number of services , collectively called the " Voice Web " , that will make this possible. All you do is use a phone or wireless device to call a phone number , and speak commands to an intuitive(直觉的) system. It will then give you the information you 're seeking , using either synthesized(综合) voice or an audio file.

In the United States and Europe , the hot technology for wireless devices is called WAP(Wireless Application Protocol) , which is being used as the world standard , WAP is supported by major phone companies including Nokia , Motorola and Ericsson , and is simply a means of transmitting information , much like HTML(超文本链接标示语言) is a means of communicating on the Internet.

Currently , wireless Internet connections may give you news , sports scores , stock quotes , and the weather reports if you 're lucky. But if you 've ever used this technology , you know it 's slow , costly and doesn 't seem worth the time and effort , if it works at all. " The mobile Internet was never designed to take over surfing the Web from a computer , " explains Cherie Gary , spokeswoman at Nokia.

All of this technology points to easier living. Maybe one day you 'll aim your phone at a soda machine , get a soda , and have the cost show up on your cellphone bill. Or perhaps you 'll need to find a restaurant for an impromptu(未经准备的) business meeting. You 'll press a button on your mobile phone , and access the Internet to pull up a list of great restaurants in your immediate area. You 'll hit another button , say a few words into the handset and you 've got a reservation for four.

Youth is not a time of life ; it is a state of mind ; it is not a matter of rosy cheeks , red lips and supple knees ; it is a matter of the will , a quality of the imagination , a vigor of the emotions ; it is the freshness of the deep springs of life.

Youth means a temperamental predominance(占优势) of courage over timidity , of the appetite for adventure over the love of ease. This often exists in a man of 60 more than a boy of 20. Nobody grows old merely by a number of years. We grow old by deserting our ideals.

Years may wrinkle the skin , but to give up enthusiasm wrinkles the soul. Worry , fear , self-distrust bows(bends) the heart and turns the spirit back to dust.

Whether 60 or 16 , there is in every human being 's heart the lure of wonder , the unfailing childlike appetite of what 's next and the joy of the game of living. In the center of your heart and my heart there is a wireless station : so long as it receives messages of beauty , hope , cheer , courage and power from men and from the Infinite(means God) , so long are you young.

When the aerials are down , and your spirit is covered with snows of cynicism(玩世不恭 , 冷嘲热讽) and the ice of pessimism , then you are grown old , even at 20 , but as long as your aerials are up , to catch waves of optimism , there is hope you may die young at 80.

E

Some houses are designed to be smart. Others have smart designs. An example of the second type of house won an Award of Excellence from the American Institute of Architects.

Located on the shore of Sullivan 's Island off the coast of South Carolina , the award-winning cube-shaped beach house was built to replace one which was smashed to pieces by Hurricane Hugo 10 years ago. In September 1989 , Hugo struck South Carolina , killing 18 people and damaging or destroying 36 000 homes in the state.

Before Hugo , many new houses built along South Carolina 's shoreline were poorly constructed , and enforcement of building codes wasn 't strict , according to architect Ray Huff , who created the cleverly-designed beach house. In Hugo 's wake , all new shoreline houses are required to meet stricter , better-enforced codes. The new beach house on Sullivan 's Island should be able to withstand a Category 3 hurricane with peak winds of 179 to 209 kilometers per hour.

At first sight , the house on Sullivan 's Island looks anything but hurricane-proof. Its red wood shell makes it resemble " a large party lantern(灯笼)" at night , according to one observer. But looks can be deceiving. The house 's wooden frame is reinforced with long steel rods to give it extra strength.

To further protect the house from hurricane damage , Huff raised it 2.7 meters off the ground on timber pilings — long , slender columns of wood anchored(抛锚) deep in the sand. Pilings might appear insecure , but they are strong e-

nough to support the weight of the house. They also elevate the house above storm surges. The pilings allow the surges to run under the house instead of running into it. "These swells of water come ashore at great speeds and cause most of the damage done to beach-front buildings," said Huff.

Huff designed the timber pilings to be partially concealed by the house's ground-to-roof shell. "The shell masks the pilings so that the house doesn't look like it's standing with its pant legs pulled up," said Huff. "In the event of a storm surge, the shell should break apart and let the waves rush under the house," the architect explained.
